

Short summary of the Action

With the action “**Partnership For Demographic And Societal Change**” Women Rights Institute during the period from 1 January 2013 to 31 December 2015 in partnership with 12 public and nongovernmental organizations of five European Union countries – Latvia, Lithuania, Cyprus, Italy and Ireland would like to promote positive changes in demographic and social environment by making solutions of problems related to such social matters as lack of education, low level of the employment, irrelevant health, violence in family, trading of people, emigration and immigration as well as limitation of human rights, and to ensure these changes in legislation of partner countries and EU in order to remove these matters to improve demographic situation.

To reach the set goal by realisation of 21 activity partners of the project will develop international cooperation, will carry out researches, will organize training in seminars and experience exchange in discussions and conferences for 2384 legislators, journalists, professionals of state institutions, municipalities, schools and private businesses will organize 5 collaboration groups for cooperation with parliament, state institutions and municipalities for improvement of legislation, will inform politicians, professionals and society on the goal of the project and demographic and social matters with informative materials on regular basis, will use modern technologies by development of the website of the project, will collect and distribute results of the research and suggestions prepared during the project in their countries and institutions of EU.

Implementation of action will be provided by 15 administrative employees. The total budget of the project is planned to be in the amount of EUR 377110,00, and partners have provided cofounding in the amount of EUR 75422,00 (20%).
